Medjugorje 2019

Once again a pilgrimage is being arranged to this village, where apparitions of Our Lady have been said to occur. The dates of the pilgrimage this year are 7th - 15th September 2019. We shall fly from Bristol Airport very early in the morning on Sunday 8th. We will therefore be staying at the Hampton (Hilton) Hotel at the airport on Saturday 7th. Travel is by minibus to the hotel. In Split we shall be met and transferred by Marian travel to our accommodation close to St James's Church in the centre of Medjugorje. The cost of £599 includes flights and bed, breakfast and evening meals in Medjugorje. Extra costs include transport to and overnight stay at the Hampton Hotel.
