Thursday 19th Surprise your parish priest with an unexpected gift or act of service.

Friday 20th Day of Fast and Abstinence. Fast from what you most like to eat or do.

Saturday 21st Pray for all traumatized by Abortion. Pray for the healing grace of repentance , conversion of heart and reconciliation.

Sunday 22nd Attend Sunday Mass. Reach out to someone you have difficulty with and pray for them.
