**Father Frank Thompson MHM, RIP.**

Father Frank was Diocesan Organiser for APF/Missio (red boxes). He visited Truro to celebrate a Mass of appreciation to all members in July each year which was usually followed by a cup of tea and a short mission film. His last visit was about five years ago when failing health forced him to give up travelling. He died in February this year a few months short of the 53rd anniversary of his ordination on 10th July 1965. All members and friends are invited to a memorial Mass in Truro on Tuesday 10th July at 6.30 pm. Parking is extremely limited in the church carpark BUT in the evenings, after 5 pm, the Council Car Park just along the road from the Catholic church in St Austell Street is FREE! It is often referred to as the "Shoppers' Carpark" but it's official name is Old Bridge Street Carpark. Garras Wharf carpark (the one adjacent to Tesco) is free from 4 pm every evening.
